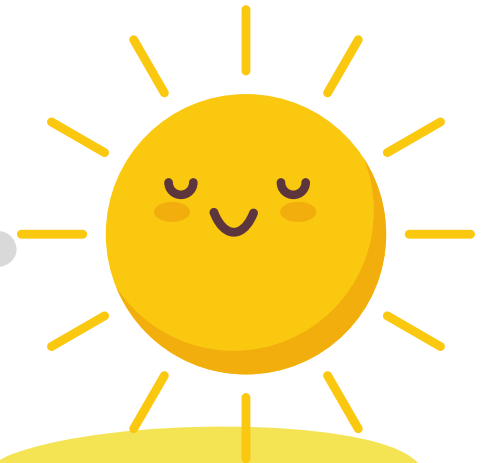
SHOW AND TELL ALL NEXT WEEK!!!
